

abc CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

English (Spoken/Phonics, Reading & Written)

Mathematics (Analytical & Pictorial/Concrete and Actual, Descriptive Skills)

Arts Education – Craft, Painting, Miming, Dancing, Music, Story Telling, Acting and others

Health & Physical Education – Basic hygiene, exercises, (team and individual oriented) tennis, swimming, running and constant outdoors time

Sex Education & Drug Awareness – Programs with caution and discipline

Society and Environmental Studies – care of one's environment, pollution and proper waste care.

Science – Basic knowledge accompanied by practical experiments are encouraged with the lessons. Basic studies from body parts and their respective functions to understanding matter are examples.

History, Geography & Culture – Emphasis is placed on Papua New Guinea and its varying rich traditions and cultures

Music & Dancing – Both Papua New Guinea and other relevant cultural and national themes are encouraged and taught wherever appropriate

OUR COMMITMENT

Since 1998, the staff membership and leadership was localized to encourage national citizens to participate more seriously and meaningfully in the training and provision of Early Childhood Care and Educational Services.

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PRINCIPLES & VALUES

Bava embraces strong family and community principles and values whilst developing and educating your child, although equal emphasis is also placed on his/her individual aspects of development with love and care.

- To develop your child socially, mentally & emotionally

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE & EDUCATION

Bava specializes in this service and truly believes in its visions which is further emphasized by its goals and aims. The first 7-8 years of a child's life is very important to their development, especially the first 3 years.

This is why Bava has made a commitment to educate Papua New Guineans as early as possible before the Governments approved elementary entry age levels.

At Bava, the elementary entry at 5-6 years is a starting point for Primary Level and we believe this is too late.

To bridge this gap, Bava exercises "Composite" structured classes or groupings. Children are assessed initially and are grouped with similar peers so that they do not find themselves isolated.

Over the past years we have experimented this method to combine Graded classes of 1 & 2 and our pupils have displayed great results. This pattern is encouraged at Bava every school year.

ACTIVITIES & FACILITIES

LIBRARY

The school has a very good library which can be utilized by the teacher, children and family members to borrow books. It is a requirement that your child has a Library bag and a Reading Folder to allow them to borrow a book at least once or twice a week.

SPORTING & PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

The school has a small playground at the front and a larger one at the back of the school. Each of them is sufficiently equipped with appropriate play equipment. Friday is our Physical Education Day, where children participate in ball games, running, quizzes, videos and pep talks. This is a very important part in the development of your growing young child.

SWIMMING POOL

There is a small pool and strict rules are observed. Gates are around the pool area for safety of the children. You will be advised of what day your child will need to bring their swimming gear.
